## **GreenPath to break ground in March on new HQ building in Farmington Hills**

Nonprofit credit counseling agency **GreenPath Inc.** said it plans to break ground in March on its new 125,000-square-foot Farmington Hills headquarters.

*Crain's* reported Thursday that the city of Farmington Hills had granted approval for **GreenPath** to build the new building near its existing campus.

The four-story building will be located on 10.5 acres of land just east of Halsted on the south side of 12 Mile Road, less than one mile from the current headquarters and less than two miles from **GreenPath's** current call center.

The new headquarters, which will accommodate up to 600 employees, will allow GreenPath to consolidate its call center and corporate functions under one roof.

The new building, which will also have over 500 parking spaces, should accommodate the agency's growth "for the foreseeable future," GreenPath said in a release.

GreenPath added employees in 2009 and 2008 in response to growing demand for credit counseling services.

**Harley Ellis Devereaux**, Southfield is serving as architect on the energy-efficient project, GreenPath said.

GreenPath said it expects to complete construction by March 2011.

The credit counseling agency, which does business as GreenPath Debt Solutions, is a national nonprofit that provides consumer education and counseling in debt management, housing, bankruptcy and money management.
