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





## **Partners**

GreenPath's partnerships expanded significantly in 2024, enhancing financial well-being nationwide. In step with hundreds of credit unions, banks, and employers, we provided thousands with the tools to build a stronger financial future through one-on-one counseling, financial webinars, online courses, and popular workshop kits.

#### **GROWTH**

 In 2024, GreenPath welcomed 40 new financial organizations to the partner family.

#### **ENGAGEMENT**

 Referrals from partners increased by 17%, counseling sessions increased 19%, and Debt Management Program (DMP) increased 7%.

#### **ENGAGEMENT**

# **Notable Grants & Projects**

Knowledge can become a powerful agent of change when communities have access to the financial education and resources they need. At GreenPath, we recognize these needs and work to empower communities—an effort made even stronger by the shared values of our partners.



#### PASS DOWN PROSPERITY

For generations, marginalized communities have faced unequal access to financial services, hindering the accumulation of generational wealth. With grant support from Chase, GreenPath developed and launched a culturally competent outreach campaign focused on Hispanic and BIPOC audiences. This initiative connects them with actionable financial counseling and education, supporting the building of generational wealth in underserved communities and providing the opportunity to pass down prosperity.



#### HELPING DETROITERS ACHIEVE HOME OWNERSHIP

Credit score calculations often disproportionately impact low-income borrowers, making homeownership difficult for low-income and BIPOC Detroiters. In partnership with Rocket Community Fund and their Detroit community partners, GreenPath designed a human-centered intervention to responsibly and effectively address low credit scores for prospective homebuyers, bringing them one step closer to homeownership.



## PARTICIPATING IN FILENE'S RACIAL ECONOMIC EQUITY INCUBATOR: PROJECT GREENOME

GreenPath partnered with Michigan State University Federal Credit Union and The Community Builders through Filene's Racial Economic Equity Incubator. Engaging with Black and Brown households in Detroit, they co-created financial education programs. Residents now have access to personalized financial empowerment paths on homeownership and credit building.


